Author Guidelines

1. Structure and styling of texts

Maximum number of characters is provided by the **special issue guest editor**. Unless stated otherwise the maximum number of characters is **47.000 characters** including spaces and full bibliography, equivalent to approximately **7.000 words**. Inserted graphics and diagrams reduce the number of characters.

Additional information

- Author`s name and address including e-mail
- Short academic profile (affiliation and profession, research focus)
- Abstract in English (around 100 words)

Citation and Footnotes

- “American citation”
- A complete bibliography has to be provided at the end of the article.
- No footnotes, only few endnotes

Italics

- book titles
- words in foreign languages

Quotation marks

- Ambiguous phraseologies, conceptual emphasis

Graphics

- Please save graphics as tif-file in 300dpi resolution.
- Please, indicate title and source.

- Please use gender sensitive writing
- Save texts as Word „.doc“ or „.rtf“ in standard-format
